Accessible Services Office

The Accessible Services Office is located at Gate 1 and can assist with any enquiries relating to accessibility, including shuttle bus bookings, wheelchair hire, accessible parking and other event information. The Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Program is a simple tool for you to voluntarily share that you have a disability or condition that may not be immediately apparent and that you may need some extra time or a helping hand. Many staff around the circuit will be wearing a Sunflower Supporter pin, so look out for them to ask questions and get support.

Accessible Shuttle

A FREE accessible shuttle service will operate within the circuit to designated stops for patrons with limited mobility. This service can accommodate one companion carer per patron. Accessible General Admission Viewing Platforms

Three General Admission viewing platforms for use by all patrons with accessible requirements and their carers are located at Turn 2-3 (via Gate 2), Turn 4-5 (via Gate 3) and Turn 12-13 (via Gate 10). All platforms are clearly signed and are managed by dedicated staff. The platforms operate on a first come, first served basis so there may be a wait if the platform is full.

Sensory Rooms

We are one of the first Grand Prix to provide a Sensory Room for our guests. There are three around the circuit. Our Sensory Play Room is located near the Customer Service Booth at Pit Stop Park. There are another two for low sensory needs: infield behind The Terraces and behind the What Ability Foundation Accessible Platform at Turn 12. All rooms have been soundproofed to offer a reduced sensory space during the Grand Prix.


